A. Craig Spitzfaden, President/CEO

Craig Spitzfaden co-founded Thin Metal Parts (TMP) in 2002 from the Specialty Products Division of Photo Stencil. Spitzfaden started TMP after realizing a great need in the industry for a company that produced quality custom thin metal parts, and has been the company's president and CEO since its inception. Spitzfaden was previously president of Photo Stencil for 4 years.

Before TMP, Spitzfaden gained extensive experience in a variety of industries. He spent 10 years as the president and CEO of a national building products company, 15 years in product and executive management in the steel distribution industry and 6 years in sales management with Xerox and IBM.
